How to get to Naples

• From Major European Cities

1. By Air:

Naples International Airport (Aeroporto di Napoli-Capodichino): Major airlines offer direct flights to Naples from many European cities

2. By Train:

High-Speed Trains (Frecciarossa, Italo): Direct high-speed trains connect Naples to Rome, Milan, Florence, and other major Italian cities. For example, from Rome, the journey takes approximately 1 hour and 10 minutes.

• From Major International Locations

1. By Air:

International Flights: Many major international airports offer connecting flights to Naples through major European hubs such as Rome, Milan, Munich, and Paris.

2. By Train (via Rome):

From Rome's Leonardo da Vinci International Airport (Fiumicino): Take the Leonardo Express train to Roma Termini (Rome's main train station). From Roma Termini, take a high-speed train (Frecciarossa or Italo) to Napoli Centrale.

• From Other Italian Cities

1. By Train:

High-Speed Trains: The main train station in Naples is Napoli Centrale. Regular high-speed trains (Frecciarossa, Italo) connect Naples with other major Italian cities such as Rome, Florence, Milan, and Bologna.

How to get to the conference venue

• From Naples International Airport (Aeroporto di Napoli-Capodichino)

1. By Taxi:

- Taxis are available outside the arrivals terminal

– The journey to Via Ammiraglio Ferdinando Acton, 38, typically takes around 20-30 minutes, depending on traffic

– Estimated cost: €20-€30

2. By Public Transport:

- Take the <u>Alibus</u> from the airport to Piazza Municipio (tickets can be purchased on board for €5)

• From Napoli Centrale Train Station

1. By Taxi:

– Taxis are available outside the station

- The journey to Via Ammiraglio Ferdinando Acton, 38 typically takes around 10-15 minutes,

depending on traffic

– Estimated cost: €15-€20

2. By Metro and Bus:

- Take Metro Line 1 (Garibaldi Station) towards Piscinola and get off at Municipio Station

Note: Naples is a bustling city with frequent traffic congestion, so it is advisable to allow extra travel time. Public transportation is generally reliable and can be a quicker option during peak hours.
